

Psalm 108

The Secret Corridors of a
Steadfast heart

“He will have no fear of bad news; his heart is steadfast, trusting in the Lord. His heart is secure, he will have no fear; in the end he will look in triumph on his foes” (Psalm 112:7-8).

Steadfast...“to be firm, be established, be faithful, be sure, be reliable, be fixed, be certain, to be ready, be prepared, to be determined; to set up, build, make ready. Denotes bringing something into existence.

Signifies initial preparation . . . also signifies the deep satisfaction and sense of well-being which comes from the certainty that one’s heart steadfastly trusts in the Lord who directs man’s path”

***15 Then the LORD said to Moses,
“Why are you crying out to me?
Tell the Israelites to move on. (Take
note of this “move on” a steadfast heart is one that acts
upon the Word of God rather than being frozen in fear
and confusion.)***

***16 Raise your staff and stretch out
your hand over the sea to divide
the water so that the Israelites can
go through the sea on dry ground***

***What are The Secret Corridors
of a steadfast heart?***

***In the first 4 verse the music of
the heart travels down the
corridor of God's great love***

**When the music of the heart
travels down the corridor of
God's great love the heart is
steadied**

***When the path we travel is
guided by the Word God speaks
we experience the
unflappableness of standing on
the unbreakable.***

**Traveling life's corridors guided
by God's Word builds a
steadfastness. God's Word
guides us along the corridors of
life.**

First with the Word of God as our
guild we can expect God himself,
the Holy Spirit to support His
word, to lead us..... prepareing us
for good works and preparing
good works for us to do
